## FSB taskforce on legal, regulatory, and supervisory matters (LRS Taskforce)

#### 1. Financial Action Taskforce (FATF) project on Recommendation 16 (wire transfers) (14:30 – 15:20)

**Objective:** To discuss the FATF's proposed revisions to Recommendation 16 (wire transfers) in addressing three priority issues: (i) adapting R16 to the changes in payment business models; (ii) improving the content and quality of basic originator and beneficiary information to achieve greater efficiencies; and (iii) presenting options that would achieve greater technical neutrality without preventing the real-time completion of the purchase of goods and services by cards/instant payments. FATF staff and project team co-lead will present the draft revisions.

#### 2. FSB work on data frameworks (15:20 – 15:30)

**Objective:** To seek input from the LRS Taskforce on the FSB's development of recommendations, for public consultation, for promoting alignment and interoperability across data frameworks: the laws, rules and regulatory requirements for collecting, storing and managing data underlying cross-border payments.

This work is being taken forward by the FSB working group on Cross-border payments data and identifiers (CPDI). To inform its work, CPDI would like to collect case studies from LRS members that provide real-world examples of data frameworks that restrict data transfer across borders. Case studies would be for internal FSB use to inform CPDI's development of recommendations, and not for publication without prior approval. The CPDI Chair, Matteo Piazza (Bank of Italy), will briefly introduce CPDI's work.
